On Sunday, Billy continued in our *Rethinking Your Life* series by talking about our view and perspective of finances. He talked about how the love of money leads to greed which leads to destruction. We studied several verses in 1 Timothy 6 where Paul lays out 4 truths about money: It won't make you happy, it doesn't last, we don't need a lot, and it's never enough. Billy taught about two different mindsets: fear which leads to greed and faith which leads to generosity. We are never more like God than when we give so we were encouraged to find opportunities to be generous, reflect the image of God and fund life change!

"Generosity isn't about getting money out of your pocket, it's about getting greed out of your heart."
