

## EASTER AT GRACE

Life change is an invitation away — and the church believed that this Easter. The prayers, the texts, the simple "Hey, do you have plans?" — they added up. Across Easter services 5,266 people walked through our doors. Every single one of them has a name and a story.

The Easter message drawn from 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 was one the whole room felt: *It's Not Over Until It's Over*. Friday looked final. Saturday felt final. But Sunday? Sunday shattered the silence. And for hundreds of people in our seats, that message landed personally — not just as history, but as hope.

- **30** kids attended Grace Kids for the first time
- **16** new families in Grace Kids
- **5** kids made a first-time decision to follow Jesus!

- Grace Kids teams creating a warm, exciting environment that welcomed 30 new kids and saw 5 of them make a first-time decision to follow Jesus.
- Volunteers, parking teams, donut runners, and greeters — every single person who showed up early and stayed late to make the weekend possible.

Life change is an invitation away. We stepped out in faith, and God was in it. Because Jesus walked out of the grave, every story represented in those seats Easter weekend is not over — it's just beginning.
